Description of Scholarships and Awards

Loyalty Scholarship

The recipients are selected by the Board of Directors and must have attended Young Americans Christian School from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Christina Carol Vernon Memorial Scholarship

Our long time teacher, Laura Newton, had a sister who was called to be with the Lord very suddenly several years ago. As she was an elementary school teacher, a scholarship fund in her honor is offered by her family. The requirements are as follows:

- 1. Be a graduating senior at Young Americans Christian School.
- 2. Plan to pursue a college degree in the teaching field
- 3. Have a letter of recommendation from one of the following:
 - Minister/Youth Minister or Sunday School Teacher
 - Teacher
 - Relative
- 4. Submit an essay of 250-500 words on the topic "Why I Want to Teach"

Light Award

The criteria for the recipients of the Light Award are the students who best exemplify Christ in their daily walks. Students are selected by the high school teachers, who evaluate students' involvement in spiritual activities during their years here at YACS. Teachers look for students who have attended three or more years and exemplify Christ-like behavior in their classrooms, school activities, and outside the school.

Eagle Award
